

**Proposal evaluation criteria in the Talent Management Mini-grant Call for proposals  
under the strategic programme Excellence Initiative  
at the Jagiellonian University  
in the academic year 2020/2021**

**Formal eligibility check:**

**Does the proposal meet the formal criteria?** (“yes” or “no”) (See: Terms and Conditions of the Talent Management Mini-grant call for proposals). If the answer “no” has been selected, a justification of up to 100 words is required, since the proposal is not subject to further evaluation.

**Proposal’s merit based evaluation. Score:** from 0 to 100 points.

**1) Is the proposal related to the Anthropocene PRA?** (“yes” or “no”). If the answer “no” has been selected, a justification of up to 100 words is required, since the proposal is not subject to further evaluation.

**2) Is the project cohesive** (accurately defined objective, subject and scope of research, research methods, tasks and results of the project, accurate identification of the problem)?

- For evaluation of research proposals use score of 0 to 5 points. Multiply the result by 8. The maximum score is 40.
- For evaluation of outreach and community engagement proposals use score of 0 to 5 points. Multiply the result by 4. The maximum score is 20.

**3) Is the implementation of the tasks proposed in the project relevant against the defined goals?**

- For evaluation of both research proposals and outreach and community engagement proposals use score of 0 to 5 points. Multiply the result by 2. The maximum score is 10.

**4) Is the proposed schedule viable?** (“yes” or “no.”) If the answer “no” has been selected, a justification of up to 100 words is required, since the proposal is not subject to further evaluation.

- For evaluation of both research proposals and outreach and community engagement proposals use score of 0 to 5 points. Multiply the result by 2. The maximum score is 10.

**5) Will the implementation of the project contribute to the completion of the tasks the Anthropocene PRA in the EI.JU** (e.g. results will be published/presented to larger audiences; they will influence the direction of further research/activities in the proposed thematic area; the implementation of the project will make a contribution in terms of knowledge/popularisation/awareness raising, among specific audiences, of broadly defined issues related to the thematic scope of the Anthropocene PRA?)

- For evaluation of research proposals use score of 0 to 5 points. Multiply the result by 4. The maximum score is 40.
- For evaluation of outreach and community engagement proposals use score of 0 to 5 points. Multiply the result by 8. The maximum score is 40.

**6) Will the implementation of the project will enable the Applicant to expand their knowledge, skills, and to develop the so-called soft skills?**

- For evaluation of both research proposals and outreach and community engagement proposals use score of 0 to 5 points. Multiply the result by 4. The maximum score is 20.

**Additional points for experience, innovation, interdisciplinarity, internationality:**  
from 0 to 50

**7) Has the Applicant any experience in terms of the proposed actions?**

- For evaluation of research proposals use score of 0 to 5 points. Multiply the result by 2. The maximum score is 10.
- For evaluation of outreach and community engagement proposals use score of 0 to 5 points. Multiply the result by 4. The maximum score is 20.

**8) Are there innovative elements in the research concept presented in the proposal** (approach to the topic, actions/research, solving the problem (e.g. collaboration of students of different JU study programmes and faculties), innovative effect (e.g. obtaining new information on the problem, developing a new method, raising the awareness of a group so far rarely included in research/actions, etc.)?)

- For evaluation of both research proposals and outreach and community engagement proposals use score of 0 to 5 points. Multiply the result by 2. The maximum score is 10.

**9) Are there interdisciplinary elements in the concept of research/actions presented in the proposal** (e.g. it includes research/activities combining different fields; problems addressed by the research/actions are part of larger interdisciplinary research/actions; the project includes preliminary research/activities that may trigger an interdisciplinary project/action; the project is carried out by persons representing different research disciplines; the procedures/actions in the project will be consulted with specialists from different fields and disciplines)?

- For evaluation of research proposals use score of 0 to 5 points. Multiply the result by 4. The maximum score is 20.
- For evaluation of outreach and community engagement proposals use score of 0 to 5 points. Multiply the result by 2. The maximum score is 10.

**10) Has the concept of research/action presented in the proposal any international dimension** (e.g. it envisages participation of foreign partners; it envisages participation of respondents/audiences from different countries in the research/action; the results of the research/activities will be disseminated internationally)?

- For evaluation of both research proposals and outreach and community engagement proposals use score of 0 to 5 points. Multiply the result by 2. The maximum score is 10.

**The maximum score in a TM call is 150 points.**
